ORGANICS PILOT RECYCLING SCHEME SURVEY RESULTS

Feedback Presentation 19 September, Gillingham Town Hall 7.00pm

People living in the Gillingham area who use the organics pilot recycling scheme are invited to a presentation at the Town Hall to hear the results of the survey conducted to evaluate the success of the scheme.

North Dorset District Council has received encouraging results from the survey and will present them at 7.00pm on Wednesday 19 September at Gillingham Town Hall.

These are some of the high-lights of the survey which canvassed more than 1000 residents:

- 92% said that it was either 'very convenient' or 'fairly convenient' to recycle their food waste and cardboard with the scheme
- 90% said they would like to see the scheme extended across the district to meet future recycling targets

These results, along with the consistently high recycling performance, are a credit to all who have been and continue to be involved in the scheme.

A full presentation of the survey results will be made at a public meeting in Gillingham Town Hall on Wednesday 19 September commencing at 7.00pm.
