

# Post Office Closures: King Stag, North Dorset

Kings Stag Post Office is combined with a small grocery store & newsagents set within a village garage services area and petrol filling station. The business also includes a small plant and garden machinery hire service. This is the only shop in the village.

This post office is proposed to be replaced by an outreach mobile service, of two hours per week.

## Concerns that this closure raises

Access to services is one of the factors considered in the measurement of the Indices of Deprivation 2007. The index ranks areas in the country for relative levels of deprivation. The 'Access' domain looks at distance to GPs, shops, post offices and primary schools. **Areas in red are within top 20% most deprived nationally.**
